

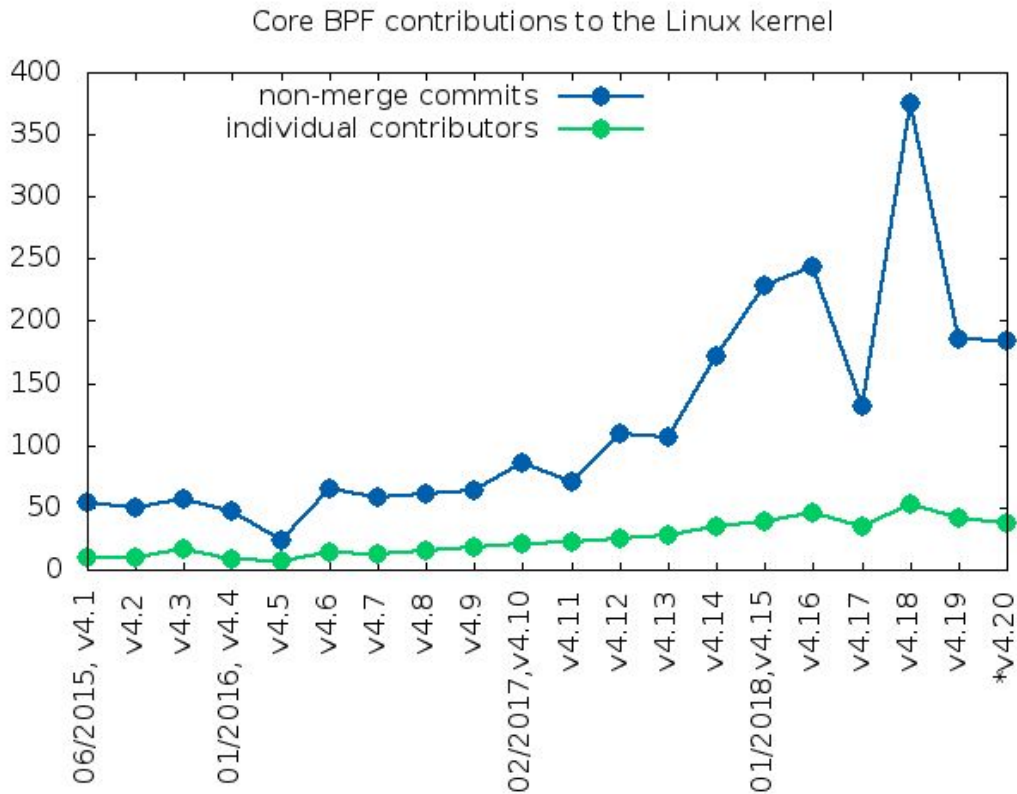

194 individual contributors.

Since Nov 2017 3,395 patches
in “bpf” patchwork delegate.
On average 9.5 patches / day.
